    - If not, figure out what you're looking at.
  - **NEVER** share information until you know what it is, and have complete trust in its accuracy.



- You should know **WHAT** you are reading **BEFORE** you read it.
    - What is the expertise and agenda of the source?
  - **CHECK:** Wikipedia, fact-checking sites, or what other sites say about this source.






# FIND

## (TRUSTED COVERAGE)



Consider the following:

- To verify if a claim is factual, look for other trusted reporting on it.
    - Look for more trusted, in-depth, or varied coverage.






# TRACE

(TO THE ORIGINAL)



Consider the following:

- Much of what we see has been stripped of context.
    - What was left out of a story/photo/video? What happened before?
    - If a news story mentions a research study, find the study, and evaluate whether the news report was accurate?
  - Go back to the **ORIGINAL source** to understand the full story.
