# **Financial Aid & Scholarships**

Choosing how you are going to fund your college education is a big decision. There are many options available and UH West O'ahu is committed to providing you with a quality educational experience at an exceptional value.

The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is the main tool we use to help you access funding for your education. Financial assistance can come in the form of grants, loans, work-study, scholarships and institutional aid based on need. Students are encouraged to submit a FAFSA application so that their financial aid eligibility can be determined. Completed applications will be considered for financial aid awards. To apply for financial aid you must be a US citizen, US national or eligible noncitizen.

#### **Priority FAFSA Application Deadline**

**Apply early!** Applications will be available sometime in December 2023 for the 2024-25 award year.



You can still apply even if you miss the priority deadline.

Regents Scholarship Deadline January 15 Resident Freshmen	Full tuition scholarship for 4 years of undergraduate study + \$4,000 a year and a one-time travel grant of \$2,000.	SAT total score of at least 1340 or ACT combined score of at least 29, 3.5 high school GPA, and evidence of remarkable extracurricular achievements.
Presidential Scholarship Deadline January 15 UH System Community College Juniors	Full tuition scholarship for 2 years of undergraduate study + \$4,000 a year and a one-time travel grant of \$2,000.	Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.7 for all college level work and evidence of superior academic achievement or creative endeavor.
Chancellor's Scholarship Deadline January 15 Resident Freshmen	Full tuition scholarship for 1 year of undergraduate study.	Minimum cumulative Hawai'i high school GPA of 3.5, and evidence of academic achievement, leadership and community service.
