Praxis I PPST: Reading (172); Math (173); Writing (171) accepted if passed on or prior to 06/30/14; OR CORE: Reading (156); Writing (162); Math (150) OR SAT Reading (530); SAT Math (560); CORE Writing (162) OR ACT Reading (18); ACT MATH (19); CORE Writing (162) OR Bachelor's Degree awarded by a regionally accredited institution of higher education.
3. Completion of a minimum of 55 credits.
4. "C-" or higher in EDEF 200, EDEF 201, EDEF 310, and SPED 304. "C-" or higher in ENG 100, ENG 200, MATH 111, PSY 340 (or PSY 240 or FAMR 230), and PSY 342.
5. 2.5 Overall GPA; This includes GPA for credits transferred to UHWO.
6. Fingerprinting and criminal background check clearance by the Hawai i Department of Education.
