









MULTI-CAMPUS ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN

Hawaiʻi Community College Honolulu Community College Kauaiʻi Community College University of Hawaiʻi Maui College and University of Hawaiʻi-West Oʻahu

Associate in Science degree in Early Childhood Education to the Bachelor of Education with a concentration in Early Childhood Education

The purpose of this Multi-Campus Articulation Agreement is to continue the partnership between the above campuses and to facilitate a smooth transition for students in the Associate in Science in Early Childhood Education (ECED) programs at Hawai'i Community College, Honolulu Community College, Kaua'i Community College and the University of Hawai'i Maui College to the University of Hawai'i West Oʻahu, as they work toward obtaining the Bachelor of Education degree with a concentration in Early Childhood Education (ECED). It is the intention of this articulation agreement that transferring students complete both AS and B.Ed degrees therefore recommended pathways have been identified. All campuses indicated above agree to work collaboratively to update and share program changes. A committee comprised of academic advisors and/or faculty from each campus will be established to oversee and maintain updates to the general education pathways and program requirements.

The UH West Oʻahu Articulation Option Recommendations listed in Attachments I-IV represent the most efficient coursework progression from the AS through the B.Ed program. To maximize the number of credits that will apply toward the baccalaureate degree at UH West Oʻahu, students are advised to complete the UH West Oʻahu Articulation Option Recommendation indicated for their home campus and consult with a Counselor or Program Advisor at their respective Community College or a Student Services Specialist at UH West Oʻahu for the most efficient transfer possible. Although individual course substitutions may be made on a case-by-case basis, all UH West Oʻahu core, general education, focus, and graduation requirements must still be met in those individual cases.

Admission to UH West O'ahu

At minimum, students who wish to enter UH West Oʻahu 's Bachelor of Education degree program with a concentration in Early Childhood Education must be eligible for transfer admission by the time of application and should complete the 32 credits of ECED Core identified below and the prerequisite coursework in Math and English required for the B.Ed program prior to transfer. The identified AS ECED core, listed below, is aligned with the UH West Oʻahu B.Ed ECED program requirements for continuity and maximum professional development.

Enrollment in 300 and 400 level UH West Oʻahu ECED courses require completion of the identified ECED Core (32 credits), Math 100 or higher-level Math and English 100 prerequisites. Any exceptions will require approval from UH West Oʻahu ECED faculty.

This agreement supports the completion of the AS ECED degree either prior to transfer or via reverse credit transfer. Interested students are encouraged to seek guidance from a Counselor or Program Advisor at their respective Community College for more information on options for AS-ECED degree completion. Students transferring prior to the completion of the AS-ECED degree will need to meet the UH West Oʻahu requirements for admission for their designated term of entry and will be responsible to complete all UH West Oʻahu core, degree, concentration, general education, focus and graduation requirements in place at the time of their admission to UH West Oʻahu.

AS-Early Childhood Education Transfer: Students who complete the Associate in Science (AS) degree in Early Childhood Education (ECED) prior to transfer may be accepted as classified students to the UH West Oʻahu's Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) degree with a concentration in Early Childhood Education through the University

of Hawai'i Automatic Admissions process, provided that eligibility, deadlines and procedures established for their designated term of entry are met. Completion of the AS program prior to transfer will enable students to follow the UH West Oʻahu core, degree, concentration, general education, focus, and graduation requirements in place on the Effective Date of this agreement. For students who complete the AS ECED degree but not all of the recommended coursework for UH West Oʻahu, additional lower division coursework to complete the general education requirements for UH West Oʻahu may be required and completed after admission to UH West Oʻahu. Current requirements for the AS degrees and the B.Ed degree form the basis for this agreement, and subsequent changes to the curricular requirements of either program may require revisions to this agreement.

This Articulation Agreement was electronically signed via Kuali on September 17, 2024, and is effective beginning Fall 2024. This agreement is based on the General Education and Focus requirements in effect at the University of Hawai'i-West Oʻahu for 2024-2025. AS in Early Childhood Education students entering the University of Hawai'i-West Oʻahu in Fall 2024 will follow the requirements outlined in this agreement. This agreement supersedes the AS in Early Childhood Education to the University of Hawai'i-West Oʻahu Bachelor of Arts in Social Sciences with a concentration in Early Childhood Education Agreement from Fall 2015.

This agreement will be subject to review as needed and may be continued, revised, or discontinued with the consent of individual or all parties. If any or all parties agree to terminate the Agreement, UH West Oʻahu. will honor the Agreement stipulations for identified students currently enrolled in the articulation agreement at the time of termination, contingent upon courses being offered.
