







Going Forward: Endemic vs Epidemic vs Pandemic








Omicron Stealth

- If you had Omicron, you are protected against Omicron stealth
- If you had delta, can still get Omicron
- Omicron Stealth vs delta: Spreads quicker but lower acuity or lower severity illness

Covid Vaccine: What if you never got initial 2 shot series

- Vaccines fully FDA approved now vs EUA
- Has been used past 1.5 year, now more data than prev immunizations
- It's a good time to get it and still worth it







What if you already had 2 shots but no booster

• One Perspective:


- "I am so done with Covid"
- "The vaccine failed me, I still got Covid"
- "They keep changing the recommendations"
- "If you are vaccinated, you can still get Covid" True statement

Another Perspective on Booster vs Unvaccinated (CDC data - Omicron Surge)

- Booster vs Unvaccinated: 7 x less likely to be hospitalized
- Booster vs Unvaccinated: 21 x less likely to die from Covid
- Boosted less likely to spread to others, including relatives
- If you never got a booster, there are still advantages to getting booster
- How long do I have to wait before booster?
 - 5 Months Moderna or Pfizer. OK to switch brands.

Omicron Hospitalization: 2 shot vs booster (CDC Study)



Treatment Options

- Pre Exposure Prophylaxis:
 - Monoclonal Evusheld
- Post Exposure
 - Monoclonal antibody: In general, as class, not very effective for Omicron
 - Antivirals: Paxlovid can be helpful, other antivirals not as effective for Omicron
