Meet Hanafuda Pilina, the card game we play the same way we've always played hanafuda. But, this time, each of the 48 cards depict different plants and animals that we can find in the Hawaiian Islands. Half of the organisms are native and half are non-native or modern invasive introductions to the islands.

Captured in the gorgeous moonlight is the wild sea turtle on one card. Included among the invasive creatures are the destructive coconut rhinoceros beetle, the stinging little fire ant and the noisy coqui frog in other cards.

These cards are a testament to the rich ecological and cultural experience of the Hawaiian Islands, and they make a very unique gift. Hanafuda Pilina combines eco-study with play. Even those folks who aren't game players will enjoy learning more about the more than 70 species in the deck of cards.
