- Miscellaneous personal expenses
- Room (includes internet access and electricity)
- Board (includes food plan plus additional food that needs to be purchased)

## Methodology:

FMR one-bedroom cost in county divided by 2 (assume shared cost). Average that cost with the cost of a HUD Efficiency unit (not shared).
Add cost of internet access and electricity.

## Cost of Living with Parents/Relatives

Assumptions (based on NASFAA Monograph):

- Room allowance minimal since housing expenses are primarily absorbed by parents or other family members. So room cost set at $25 \%$ of the off-campus cost.
- All other COA components (e.g., transportation, etc.) are the same for student living in off-campus housing (not with parents), with the exception of food costs which are not increased by $10 \%$ as is done for off-campus students.


## Cost of Internet Access and Electricity

Sources:
Internet access -- Average price of service from HawaiianTel and Spectrum
Electricity -- DBEDT average residential costs (about \$1,000 to \$1,300 per month for off-campus students not living with parents)

Methodology: Use Hawaiian Airlines price calendar and query for highest and lowest costs from October 1 through December 13 for various island combinations based on typical student travel.

Determine median of all high and low costs, add baggage fee to get average cost per neighbor island trip. Multiply by 3 trips per academic year.
