Methodology:

Cost of Living with Parents/Relatives

Assumptions (based on NASFAA Monograph):

- Room allowance minimal since housing expenses are primarily absorbed by parents or other family members. So room cost set at 25% of the off-campus cost.
- All other COA components (e.g., transportation, etc.) are the same for student living in off-campus housing (not with parents), with the exception of food costs which are not increased by 10% as is done for off-campus students.
