# **Survey of Recent Graduates**

# University of Hawai'i West O'ahu

Fall 1997 to Spring 1999

UHWO Assessment Office 11/10/99

The University of Hawai'i West O'ahu Survey of Recent Graduates was sent out on August 6, 1999. Three hundred thirty-three questionnaires were sent, 134 were returned for a response rate of 40.2%. All UHWO graduates from Fall 1997 to Spring 1999 with valid current addresses were sent questionnaires.

The characteristics of the <u>respondents</u> were compared to the student <u>population</u> of Fall 1997 and Fall 1998. Respondents to this survey had higher proportions of females than the student population (74% vs 65%). The estimated mean age (estimated from interval choices) of the respondents was similar to the mean age of the population (33 years vs 32 years). And the proportion of respondents by ethnicity was also similar to the population (the only differences were for Caucasians - about 2 percentage points higher for respondents, and for Japanese - about 2 percentage points lower, but about the same for the rest.)

The questionnaire is given in Appendix A. The overall results are given in Appendix B. Results by division is given in Appendix C. Some of the highlights are listed below.

#### **Overall impression of UH West O'ahu:**

- Sixty-five percent of the respondents said that the *quality of academic programs at UHWO* was better than they expected. The highest rate of satisfaction came from the Social Science respondents (76%).
- Fifty-five percent said that the *overall quality of their total academic experience* was of excellent quality while 41% said it was of good quality. The highest satisfaction rate was with the Humanities respondents (76%).

 Forty-nine percent said that the *quality of campus life at UH West O'ahu* was better than they expected. Respondents from Public Aministration, Social Sciences, and the Humanities all rated this question at about 58%.

#### **Current or Future Plans:**

- Seventy-two percent of the valid respondents said that they were either "planning to" (51%) or are "now in" (21%) *graduate school*. The highest division was the Social Science respondents with 80% for either "planning to" (58%) or "now in" (23%).
- Thirty-nine percent said that they were planning to or were *currently attending* Manoa, 21% said a mainland university, 13% Chaminade, 9% HPU.
- 6. Forty-one percent intend to get a better *job*, 34% want to stay and advance within their present job, and 26% want to do something else.
- Seventy-one percent plan to *work* on O'ahu, 9% on a Neighbor Island, 20% on the Mainland.

#### **Impressions about Specific Programs at UHWO:**

 8. Fifty-eight percent were <u>very satisfied</u> with the *overall quality of instruction in their specialization*, 34% were <u>satisfied</u>, 8% were <u>somewhat satisfied</u> and 1% not satisfied. The Humanities respondents had the highest satisfaction rate here (80% were <u>very satisfied</u>) followed closely by the Social Sciences (77%).

- Twenty-nine percent were <u>very satisfied</u> with the *organization of the curriculum*, 49% satisfied, and 3% not satisfied. The highest division percentage was the Social Sciences with 42% being <u>very satisfied</u>.
- 10. With regard to the *availability of courses in their specialization*, 23% were very satisfied, 45% were satisfied, 26% somewhat satisfied, 6% not satisfied. Forty percent of the Social Science respondents reported this as <u>very satisfied</u>.
- 11. On the *adequacy of the library collection in their specialization*, 23% were very satisfied, 45% satisfied, 26% somewhat satisfied, 6% not satisfied. Thirty-eight percent of the Humanities respondents reported being very satisfied.
- 12. On the *quality of information about student services and activities*, 23% felt it was excellent, 53% good, 20% fair, and 4% poor.

#### **Gains from Collge Experience:**

13. The most frequently cited gains were: "Increased knowledge in an academic field" (81%) and "Increased understanding of other people and their points of view" (81%). The least frequently cited gains were: "Increased involvement in cultural and artistic activities" (24%) and "A meaningful philosophy of life" (38%).










Graph 1: Q33 Admission and Registration Procedures (% Used & satisfied)




### Graph 2: Q34 Cashier's office (% Used & satisfied)




# Graph 3: Q35 Academic Advising by Faculty (% Used & satisfied)




#### Graph 4: Q36 Academic Advising by Student Services Specialists (% Used & satisfied)




### Graph 5: Q37 Testing Services (% Used & satisfied)




### Graph 6: Q38 Financial Aid (% Used & satisfied)




### Graph 7: Q39 Library (% Used & satisfied)
