

The Yellow Ribbon GI Education Enhancement Program is a provision of the Post-9/11 Veterans Educational Assistance Act of 2008. This program allows institutions of higher learning (degree granting institutions) in the United States to voluntarily enter into an agreement with the Department of Veterans Affairs to fund tuition expenses that exceed the public in-state undergraduate tuition rate. The institution can contribute up to 50% of those expenses and the Department of Veterans Affairs will match the same amount as the institution. Schools participating in the Yellow Ribbon Program are required to offer participation to students on a first-come, first-served basis. ### Eligibility Requirements

- Post-9/11 GI Bill® (Chapter 33) Certificate of Eligibility showing Yellow Ribbon Program eligibility
- Classified as a non-resident student paying the non-resident tuition rate
- Admitted to a degree program for the semester in which benefits are being requested with UH West O'ahu as your home institution

Note: Active duty personnel receiving Chapter 33 benefits and spouses of active duty personnel receiving Transfer of Entitlement (ToE) benefits are not eligible for the Yellow Ribbon Program.

### Application Process

For the 2024-2025 academic year, UH West O'ahu will offer Yellow Ribbon Program awards to students who meet the eligibility requirements on a first-come, first-served basis. To apply, students must submit ALL of the following documents as one application packet to be considered:

- Copy of the student's VA Certificate of Eligibility showing Yellow Ribbon Program eligibility
- UH West O'ahu 2024-2025 Yellow Ribbon Program Application
- UH West O'ahu Veteran Student Enrollment Certification Form

Completed application packets will be accepted for the 2024-2025 academic year beginning June 1, 2024. Documents submitted before this date will not be accepted. **The application deadline is August 26, 2024 for Fall 2024 and January 13, 2025 for Spring 2025.**

Submit the completed form to the Office of the Registrar, C-141 or use UH File Drop at <https://www.hawaii.edu/filedrop/> and enter "uhwova@hawaii.edu" as the recipient. Please allow 5-7 business days within receipt for processing.

### Notification Process

Eligible students who submit their application packet will be notified by through their UH email account of their award status. The 2024-2025 Yellow Ribbon Program award is valid from August 1, 2024 to July 31, 2025.

### Statement of Acknowledgement:

- The University's maximum contribution for the 2024-2025 academic year is \$6480 and I understand that I may have to pay any outstanding balance I may incur for a fall, spring, or summer term with my own funds.
